There are many different cords for the numerous peripheral devices that can be connected to your computer. The main slots in your computer will be:



- **a.** USB- for connecting devices such as cameras, external back up drive, phone, etc.
- **b.** VGA- for connecting a monitor or projector
- **c.** Firewire- for connecting to video cameras, etc.
- d. SD card reader- for inserting media devices to transfer from cameras, phones, etc
- e. HDMI- for connecting to flat screens TVs
- **f.** Ethernet- for connecting directly to the modem

Right click on the desktop, choose Peronalize, and have fun!



Setting Up Your Computer

1. Gadgets- Add features to your screen.

Do this by Right clicking on any blank area of the screen, go to *Gadets*, then choose what you want.

2. Tool Bar

Choose what you want to be seen in the toolbar at the bottom of the screen by "pinning" and "un-pinning." Pin by dragging on to the tool bar. Un-Pin by right clicking and choosing "unpin.

Folders

Make, change size, move, drop and manipulate folders.

To make a folder: Right click anywhere on the screen, choose *New*, then *Folder*. Rename folder.



Ctrl+N-New Ctrl+I- Italicize Ctrl+O-Open Ctrl+B- Bold Ctrl+S-Save Ctrl+Z- Undo Ctrl+X- Cut Ctrl+Y- Redo

Ctrl+C- Copy Ctrl+Home – Goes to beginning of document


Ctrl+V- Paste Ctrl+End- Goes to end of document








- 4. Backup with a backup external hard drive as well as online. Carbonite or Mozy.
